## MAIL-IN DOG REGISTRATION Starting June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024

Connecticut law requires that, each year, all dogs must be registered during the month of June. The license you purchase on or after July 1, 2024, expires on June 30, 2025. The law applies to all dogs aged 6 months of age or older. Dog licenses are available in the Town Clerk's Office during regular town hall business hours:

This form may be used for mail-in dog registration. Please fill in all the blanks and remit the appropriate fee, making your check payable to "*Naugatuck Town Clerk*". For each dog you intend to license, you must enclose written proof of Rabies Vaccination (see notice below), written proof of spaying or neutering (if applicable), and a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of the tag and license.

## **RABIES VACCINE CERTIFICATE REQUIRED**

Sec. 22-338(b), Connecticut General Statutes, requires any Connecticut dog owner applying for a dog license to submit to the town clerk a rabies certificate, signed by a veterinarian, stating that such dog has been vaccinated against rabies, the date of the vaccination and the duration of the immunity provided by the vaccine.

## PENALTY NOTICE

Sec. 22-338(a), Connecticut General Statutes, requires that penalties be assessed at the rate of \$1.00 additional per month, for each month that a dog is not licensed according to law. If you fail to license your dog during the month of June, you must include the correct penalty in your payment.
